Prof Rob Shepherd, Program Leader, Preclinical Program, Bionic Vision Australia and Director of the Bionic Ear Institute, will discuss the latest progress in the development of the BVA Consortium's retinal prosthesis and updates on Bionic Vision Australia's research program.



Dr Nicholas Price from the pre-clinical team at the Monash Vision Group consortium will highlight how they are testing the biocompatibility of their prosthesis in a direct-to-brain bionic eye system, which encompasses a focus on redesigning vision, from understanding the brain to controlling the brain.
